## The Grécourt Match - Round 2 Status

As you know, a generous member of the Class of '82 has committed \$1 million for financial aid. This second Match began on July 1, 2022. Every \$10 of a newly documented planned gift will be matched by \$1 from this pool, up to a limit of \$10,000 per match.



As of 3/21/24, The Grécourt Match, round 2 – has over 150 participants and has released over \$820,000.00 to current financial aid. We still hope to meet the \$1m goal by 6/30/24!

## Secure Act 2.0 (Legacy IRA)

Beginning in January 2023 those at least 70½ years of age can fund a Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA) with their Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from their IRA. The maximum one-time CGA amount is now at \$53k!
