The new Match already has over 25 participants and as of this printing, has released more than \$175,000 to financial aid.

Fiscal Year 2022 report

We have enclosed a copy of the fiscal year report for 2022. We had an outstanding fundraising year. Overall, \$82 million in new gifts, pledges, and grants were contributed to the college. Support through the Smith Fund for the college's immediate use in the operating budget totaled \$12.1 million. The total of all planned gifts was **\$27,983,228.69**.
